Who can participate?

- Adults who have aphasia after a stroke
- 18 years or older

What does participation involve?

- Answer questions about your language and cognitive abilities
- Three online sessions that occur at 8-week intervals that last 2.5-3.5 hours each
- You may also be asked to meet with a music therapist/SLP once a week and complete 30 minutes of music or audiobook listening a day
- Compensation: \$50.00 for completing each online session
