## **Centers/ Interest Areas in the Classroom**

Infant Area: Infant mat with soft bright colored toys to hold and mouth, mirrors
 SE1.1 Communicate to indicate physical and emotional needs, SE2.1 Develop self-soothing when adult provides comfort techniques

Large Motor: Climber with steps, tunnel and slide for physical education and health
 PHG2.2 use simple movement skills to participate in active physical play, coordination and balance,
 PHG2.2 Interact with adults in physical activities

Toddler: (P/H) Option 2 = sensory tubes and non-slip-colored mats

Body Awareness: Toys and areas to allow infants to stand, explore body movement
 PHG3.1 begin to develop coordination and balance, requiring less support, PHG2.2 Show awareness
 of own body, start to move intentionally

Toddler: (S/R) Option 2 = picture of rowing a boat

Infant: (P/H) Option 2 = Clap book

• Fine Motor: piggy banks, stacking cake
