- Lori became a surgeon at a time when few women were granted an opportunity. She realized the delicate Native beadwork patterns she learned as a child was helpful when performing difficult heart procedures.
- Lori wrote an inspirational book based on her life and work as a surgeon entitled The Scalpel and the Silver Bear.
