## IMMUNIZATION RECORD

Read each immunization requirement carefully. As a nursing student, many of the required immunizations are more extensive than those required by the University of the General Student Body. All vaccinations and required serological evidence of immunity listed below must be completed. Nothing may be omitted.

**Required Immunizations**

<b>Measles (Rubeola), Mumps and Rubella (MMR)</b> Must have 2 doses at least 4 weeks apart ----- OR Born prior to 1957 and one dose of MMR ----- Or Serological evidence of immunity, date of positive titer	<b>Upload verification from healthcare provider with date(s)</b>
<b>Varicella (chickenpox)</b> Must have 2 doses at least 28 days apart ----- Or Serological evidence of immunity, date of positive titer <b>Date of disease is NOT sufficient – must have vaccination or positive titer</b>	<b>Upload verification of vaccine dates or titer results from healthcare provider.</b>  <b>Date of disease is NOT sufficient – must have vaccination or positive titer</b>
<b>Tetanus/Diphtheria/Acellular Pertussis (Tdap)</b> Must have been vaccinated within the past 10 years.	<b>Upload verification from healthcare provider with date(s)</b>
<b>Polio</b> (Series of three plus booster; oral or injectable)	<b>Upload verification from healthcare provider with date(s)</b>
<b>Hepatitis B</b> Serologic evidence of immunity in the form of a <b>positive Hepatitis B Surface Antibody titer</b> at least 1-2 months after final vaccine dose. If titer is negative, consult with PUSON Student Services.	<b>Upload verified POSITIVE titer results from healthcare provider</b>
<b>TB</b> <b>Two-step tuberculosis skin test (baseline PPD followed 1 – 3 weeks later by 2<sup>nd</sup> PPD which is then “read” to identify mm of induration)</b> <b>OR</b> <b>QuantiFeron Gold Blood Test</b> ----- <b>If positive, chest X-ray or Interferon Gamma Release Assay Blood Test required with appropriate follow-up</b>	Upload verified test results from healthcare provider: Two PPD tests 1 – 3 weeks apart <b>indicating mm reading</b> as 1 PDF, X-ray results or QuantiFeron Gold blood test results
<b>Influenza</b> (annual – within 30 days of when vaccine becomes available in the fall)	<b>Upload verified proof of vaccine from healthcare provider when new vaccine is available in the fall.</b>
<b>Recommended, not Required Immunizations and are not tracked by the School of Nursing</b>

Required and recommended vaccinations may be modified annually based on the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations and clinical agency requirement.
