Criteria for Selection of Traineeship:

As a result of a grant from the Human Resources and Service Administration (HRSA), the Purdue School of Nursing has been awarded funding to support fourteen Traineeships. Each traineeship is for \$22,000 which includes tuition, books, and a stipend for living support for a one-year period*. The purpose is to support students so that they do not have to work full-time and can focus on graduate education to complete the program with a full-time plan of study. Please note the qualifications for the Traineeship noted below.

Eligible Applicants Will:

- File an application for graduate student financial aid
- Enroll as a full-time student in either the MS program, the BSN to DNP program, or the Post-Masters Certificate program
- Enroll in a NP clinical course by January 2019 and complete 210 clinical hours prior to June 30, 2019
- Agree to complete a minimum of 210 hours of clinical in one of our clinical partner facilities:
 - Riggs Community Health Center or North Central Nursing Clinics
- Hold and maintain a grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Provide proof of United States citizenship
- Submit a 500-word (approximate) essay on the questions “If awarded, how this traineeship would influence my short and long-term career goals (be specific)” and “How I see myself advancing primary care for rural and underserved populations.” Please also identify how this traineeship would impact your work schedule (e.g., would you continue to work full-time, part-time, or not at all). Please note that your essay will be assessed on both content and format.

Traineeship Awardees: The application will be considered on a competitive basis. Traineeships will be awarded contingent on the School of Nursing receiving the funding from HRSA.
