- (6) International Selective: Choose from the International selective list or complete a 3 credit study abroad course.
- (7) Students may opt for the Study Abroad Internship Program in Dublin, London, or Sydney (6 credits) or complete the Interns for Indiana Internship (3 credits) to fulfill this requirement.
