The Taskforce is charged with assessing how DEI with respect to LGBTQ is incorporated across the curriculum undergraduate and graduate, recruitment and retention materials, and the Office of Nursing Research Portfolio. The Taskforce will issue a comprehensive report upon completion of its work. Additionally, I serve on the “Big Ten Schools” Diversity Initiative, which is examining how DEI is incorporated in schools of nursing in the Midwest. Also, I serve on the DEI Working Group that developed in conjunction with an outside consultant a comprehensive set up recommendations to advance DEI across three campuses. Finally, I have devoted my career to promoting equity and inclusion for African American MSM with HIV/AIDS specifically for research inclusion and reduction of health disparities in HIV transmission, and to increasing diversity in nursing schools and the profession. I co-created a signature post-doctoral scholar’s pipeline program University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing aimed to recruit diverse faculty into nursing academics. The university President used our program to establish a Presidential Postdoctoral Program university-wide to recruit diverse faculty scholars.
