

**College of Health and Human Sciences
Career Research Achievement Award**

Eligibility: Tenure-track associate professors with at least three years in rank and full professors are eligible. The nominee must have been on faculty for at least three years prior to nomination.

Criteria: We seek to recognize strong scientific/scholarly contributions as a result of work completed in their role as a Purdue faculty member. Candidates should have demonstrated a sustained and significant impact on their field and national and international recognition for their work.

Nomination: Any tenured associate or full professor can nominate. The unit head must endorse the nomination, and each unit can nominate only one individual. The nomination must include:

- Cover page (template on the second page)
- Letter of nomination
- Two representative publications
- Shortened CV (5 pages maximum)
- Letter of support from one external reference (not in your unit, but can be from campus)
- A one-paragraph description or a website link with the credentials of the external reviewer

Deadline: One nomination per unit is due electronically as one PDF through Qualtrics at [https://HHS Fellowship_Award Submissions](https://HHS_Fellowship_Award_Submissions) by **5:00 p.m. on January 21, 2022.**

Evaluation: The Health and Human Sciences Research Advisory Council will review the applications.

Recognition: The College awardee will present at the Fall Research Day and will receive a monetary award of \$1,000.
