

Talent-based hiring: The targeted recruiting of top faculty through the Moveable Dream Hires program, with notable high-caliber faculty being recruited to Purdue. Leverage the benefits of working collectively as a single University to effectively marshal our resources irrespective of administrative silos. The program works best as an ongoing, evergreen hiring opportunity for outstanding talent and will continue seamlessly into next year's hiring.

Research

Sponsored Programs (system -wide with PARI)

- Proposals 4,298 (up 421 or 11% from 3,877), \$3B (up \$750M or 33% from \$2.25B)
 - HHS Proposals 310.96 (up 4.23 or 1.38% from 306.73 last year);
 \$197M (down \$12M or 5.7% from \$209M last year)
- Awards \$757.5M (up \$135M or 22% from \$622.4M)
 - HHS Awards \$54.3M (up \$15.2M or 38.6% from \$39.1M last year). This is a new FY record for HHS by far. FY 2023 was the previous record. HHS had the largest per year growth over any other college except Daniels School of Business.
- Expenditures \$616.8M (up \$51.8M or 9% from \$565.1M)
 - HHS Expenditures \$38.7M (up \$6.7M or 21% from \$32M last year). Also, a new FY record for HHS- old record was \$38.4M in FY17. HHS had the 2nd largest % increase of all colleges, after Education (25.7%).

Purdue Office of Research Seed for Success Acorn Awards −2024 Extramural sponsored awards for >\$1M for FY 2024 (-71-2023 thru 6-30-2024)

- 16 awards featured a total of 26 HHS people (20 faculty, 6 staff)
- Of the 26 HHS people, 6 are firstime recipients.
- 15 awards list one or more PIs from HHS (14 faculty, one staff)
- Three HHS faculty—Jason Cannon, Jennifer Freeman, and Shelley MacDermid Wadsworth —received two awards each as Pls.

Our HHS grand total is \$38,713,455 in large awards.


