HHS Dean's Fellow Update

Broadly defined goals of the fellow position

- Think creatively and strategically about ways in which community, belonging and identity-safety can be fostered among HHS faculty
- Obtain input from faculty that enables individualization in program planning and execution, tailored to faculty desires and needs
- Implement events and activities that provide opportunities for faculty to form meaning connections; programming may be generalized for postdoctoral scholars and graduate students
- Develop metrics to measure success, and assess success
- Contribute to current HHS programming that fosters belonging and honors unique difference of faculty and their experiences; introduce new elements to elevate this activity



HHS Dean's Fellow Update

Initial activity

- Explored current efforts/programming that fosters belonging and honors unique difference of faculty and their experiences at peer institutions
- Developed a framework for how goals could be approached in this role
- Attended faculty meetings in each unit to share information about myself and role
- Initiated R.I.S.E. and Be...You at Purdue
- 105 faculty opted to receive information regarding R.I.S.E. and Be...You
- Critical Conversations talk
- Held ~15 small group/1:1 focus group meetings with faculty to obtain feedback

- Acknowledgement of issues regarding DEI that include current climate and faculty needs
- Formal recognition of efforts in advancing DEI
- Opportunities to make meaningful connections
- Pathways for professional development and career advancement
